SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

KMC Telecom III LLC ("KMC" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, hereby seeks authorization pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue the provision of domestic telecommunications service to certain customers in Florida, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas.

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KMC has limited operations in Florida, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas. In these states, KMC currently provides long distance and toll free services via switched or dedicated facilities, and customers may purchase the services in conjunction with KMC's local service or on a "Standalone" basis. KMC intends to discontinue offering switched intrastate long distance and toll free services to customers who purchase only

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long distance or toll free service from KMC. The following chart details the number of affected customers in each state.

Customers who purchase long distance or toll free services in addition to, or in conjunction with, local service from KMC will not be affected.

KMC has targeted the following three service discontinuance dates – March 10, 2003 (Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee); April 6, 2003 (Florida, Maryland) and April 12, 2003 (Texas) – each of which will provide customers with a minimum of thirty (30) days to transition to another service provider. KMC sent notice to the affected customers on February 3, 2003.

KMC respectfully requests that the Commission issue its public notice of the proposed discontinuance as soon as possible, so that service may be discontinued in accordance with the projected termination dates discussed above.

KMC provides the following information pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules:

 <u>Name and Address of the Carrier</u>: KMC is located at 1545 Route 206, Suite 300, Bedminster, New Jersey 07921.

2. <u>Date of Planned Service Discontinuance</u>: Subject to final regulatory and other approvals, the anticipated dates for KMC's discontinuance of service are on or after March 10,

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2003 (Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee); April 6, 2003 (Florida, Maryland); and April 12, 2003 (Texas).

3. <u>Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected</u>: KMC will discontinue providing domestic telecommunications services to Standalone switched long distance and toll free service customers throughout KMC's service areas in Florida, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas.

4. <u>Brief Description of Type of Service Affected</u>: KMC intends to discontinue offering switched long distance and toll free services to customers who purchase only long distance or toll free service from KMC. Customers who purchase switched intrastate long distance service or toll free services in addition to, or in conjunction with, local service from KMC will not be affected.

5. <u>Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers</u>: As of February 3, 2003, notices were mailed to KMC's customers in Florida, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas. These notices advised cus⁺ there of the proposed discontinuance of service by KMC and the need to arrange service from another carrier.

6. <u>Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with respect to the</u> <u>Services to be Discontinued</u>: KMC is considered to be a non-dominant carrier with respect to the services to be discontinued.

7. <u>Service of Application</u>: A copy of this application is being served on the Governors and state public utility commissions of each state affected and on the Special Assistant for Telecommunications of the Secretary of Defense.

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WHEREFORE, KMC Telecom III LLC respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Application to discontinue the services described herein. In consideration of this request, the Applicant submits that the public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected by the discontinuance of service in the aforementioned states because other carriers are available to provide the same services and sufficient notice has been given for the customers to arrange for substitute service.
