Dear Mr. Smith:

The Commission received the company's 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form, along with partial payment, and a note requesting cancellation of your certificate. As information, the Regulatory Assessment Fee is .0015% of a company's intrastate revenues, or \$50.00, whichever is greater.

In this case, you paid \$2.02, leaving a balance of ~~\$47.98~~. Since full payment of the Regulatory Assessment Fee was not received by the due date of January 30, 2003, statutory penalty and interest charges now apply. If payment of the balance is postmarked by March 1, 2003, the penalty is 5% of the balance (\$2.40) and the interest is 1% of the balance (\$0.48), for a total due of \$50.86 for the 2002 fee. It should be noted that the penalty and interest charges continue to accrue until the balance is paid. In addition, our records show you have a \$2.58 balance for late payment of the 2001 fee. A breakdown is attached. This means that if your check is postmarked by March 1st, the total due for both years is \$53.44.
