- 5. Does O&S Water Company anticipate receiving any FGUA connections charges from connections in the Bellalago? If so, approximately how many?
- 6. Does O&S Water company anticipate receiving any FGUA connections charges from connections in the Yates Subdivision? If so, approximately how many?
- 7. Does O&S Water company anticipate receiving these FGUA connections charges from developers or individual home buyers?

- 8. How many residential connections are anticipated to be served in the Bellalago subdivision?
- How many residential connections are anticipated to be served in the Yates subdivision?
