# COMMENTS OF THE MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

DOCKET NO. P5426/M-03-232

#### I. BACKGROUND

On February 10, 2003, KMC Telecom III LLC (KMC) filed a notification that it wishes to discontinue offering switched intrastate long distance and toll free services to customers who purchase only long distance or toll free service from KMC. KMC stated that it has sixteen customers in Minnesota who purchase only long distance or toll free service. On February 3, 2003, it provided a minimum of a 30-day notice to secure service from another provider. The anticipated date of KMC's discontinuance of service if March 10, 2003 in Minnesota; however, KMC acknowledges that discontinuance of service is subject to regulatory approval.

#### II. STATEMENT OF ISSUES

Whether the Commission should approve the request by KMC to discontinue offering switched intrastate long distance and toll free services to customers who purchase only long distance or toll free service from KMC.

#### III. DISCUSSION OF LAW AND DEPARTMENT POLICY

Minn. Stat. § 237. 16, subd. 5 says, "any certificate of authority may, after notice of hearing and a hearing, be revoked or temporarily suspended, in whole or in part, for: . . . failure to meet the terms and conditions of its certificate.

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#### IV. ANALYSIS

KMC was granted authority to provide long distance, switched and special access local exchange service in Docket No. P5426/NA-96-1305 on January 3, 1997. KMC is an authorized interexchange telecommunications carrier that has chosen to discontinue offering switched intrastate long distance and toll free services to its 16 customers in Minnesota who purchase only long distance or toll free service from KMC. These customers have been give a minimum of a 30-day notice of the proposed discontinuance of service, and they will need to arrange service from another carrier. Customers who purchase long distance or toll free services in addition to, or in conjunction with, local service from KMC will not be affected.

Department policy encourages competition unhindered by unnecessary regulation in the telecommunications marketplace. Companies make decisions to discontinue service for variety of reasons that often are meant to achieve a better competitive edge. Companies should be permitted to freely make such changes as long as the decisions receive approval from the agencies charged with reviewing the impacts of company action upon the public. KMC modified its tariff to reflect this restriction to its interexchange authority in Docket No. P5426/M-03-211 on February 13, 2003. The Department reviewed that tariff modification and found that it complied with Commission requirements.

#### V. RECOMMENDATION

Approve KMC III LLC's request to discontinue offering its switched intrastate long distance and toll free services to customer who purchase only long distance or toll free service.
