Dear Mr. Belfiore:

I wanted to get back with you since my February 12th letter and your \$50.00 payment (received on February 13th) crossed in the mail. The following events have transpired in this case:

- 12/12/02 - The 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form was mailed to you. Payment was due by January 30, 2003, to avoid statutory penalty and interest charges.
- 01/07/03 - The Commission received the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee return, without payment, and a note "Sold business."
- 01/08/03 - I wrote you a letter which explained that if the \$50.00 minimum Regulatory Assessment Fee was received by the due date of January 30, 2003, a docket would be established to grant you a voluntary cancellation with an effective date of December 31, 2002.
- 01/28/03 - You called me and stated that you had sold your business about four years ago and asked if you had to pay the 2002 fee. I advised yes and asked you to write a letter requesting cancellation. I advised you that the fee and letter must be postmarked by January 30th. We discussed the fact that a certificate is good for the entire state of Florida, since you mentioned you would be moving to the East Coast of Florida. You ended the conversation by stating you would cancel the certificate.
- 01/30/03 - Payment for the \$50.00 fee was not received, nor was a letter received requesting cancellation.
- 02/12/03 - I wrote you a letter and explained that since you did not pay the 2002 fee by the due date of January 30th, and did not formally request cancellation of your certificate, you now owed the 2002 fee (\$50.00), statutory penalty and interest charges for late payment (\$3.00), and the 2003 fee (\$50.00), for a total of \$103.00. A response was requested by March 1, 2003.

- 02/13/03 - The Commission received a check for \$50.00. We did not receive the penalty and interest nor a letter requesting cancellation.

Since payment and the request for cancellation was not postmarked by January 30, 2003, Sam's B Enterprises owes \$53.00. If they are not received by March 31, 2003, an enforcement docket may be opened for violation of Commission rules. If Sam's B Enterprises' payphone certificate is cancelled involuntarily, any unpaid RAFs will be turned over to collections.
