

hereby object to certain specified portions of Order No. PSC-03-0351-PAA-SU and put in dispute

the issues specified in this pleading. In support of this objection, the Citizens submit the following:

1. The agency affected is the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC), 2540 Shumard Oak

Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850. The docket number is Docket No. 020344-SU.

4. The Citizens raise the following issues for dispute, along with the respective position taken for each issue.

FPSC-COMMISSION CLERK

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CITIZENS' POSITION: No. The utility should bear some of these costs.

b. Should the used and useful ratio for the collection system be reduced?

CITIZENS' POSITION: Yes. The collection system used and useful ratio should be lowered.

c. Are there certain related party transactions that should be adjusted to simulate an arm's length situation?

CITIZENS' POSITION: Yes. The Commission should adjust for certain related party transactions.

d. Should the utility be penalized for failing to provide adequate quality of service?CITIZENS' POSITION: Yes.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens of the State of Florida protest and object to Order No. PSC-03-0351-PAA-SU, and seek a hearing to present evidence and argument on the issues raised in this protest.
