Dear Ms. Edmunds:

On March 14, 2003, the Commission received your letter dated March 11th, which requested cancellation of the company's pay telephone certificate and included payment for the \$50 minimum 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee. There are two kinds of cancellations. The first is voluntary, which is normally granted if the company is in good standing with the Commission and does not have a past due balance of the Regulatory Assessment Fee, including statutory penalty and interest charges. The other is involuntary. If a company is <u>not</u> in good standing and has an outstanding balance of the Regulatory Assessment Fee, the Commission normally cancels the certificate on its own motion for a rule violation. It should be noted that any balance owed is turned over to collections.

The Regulatory Assessment Fee is assessed if a certificate is active for any one day during a calendar year. The Regulatory Assessment Fee is due by January 30 of each year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the fee is due by the next working day, for the previous year. If payment for the Regulatory Assessment Fee is mailed after the due date, then statutory penalty and interest charges are applicable.

Since payment of the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee was not postmarked until March 12, 2003, the company owes \$6 penalty and interest charges. In addition, the effective date of a cancellation is the date that the Commission received a company's request for cancellation. In this case, the Commission received your request March 14, 2003, therefore, the company will owe the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee, even if the company is no longer in business or, in fact, never went into business. Rule 25-24.514, Florida Administrative Code, provides that a company requesting voluntary cancellation must either pay the current year's fee (2003) or provide a date certain that it will be paid, such as within 30 days after the Commission Order is issued granting the voluntary cancellation. The 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form is also attached.

Therefore, based on the above information, I cannot recommend a voluntary cancellation of your certificate unless the past due balance is paid. Please respond in writing by April 4, 2003, and
