We are in receipt of the above referenced consumer request #520349W for Mr. Bill Sloot regarding his inquiry into the availability of treated reclaimed water. At present, The Sanctuary subdivision in which Mr. Sloot resides has the reclaimed water distribution system installed. However, the main transmission system, which will connect to the distribution system within the subdivision, is not complete to date. The reclaimed water transmission system, currently under construction by Alafaya Utilities, Inc., will be available to provide reclaimed water to Mr. Sloot's residence by May 2003.

At the time reclaimed water becomes available to Mr. Sloot's residence, door hangers will be hung throughout the neighborhood to notify all residences within the Sanctuary that reclaimed water is now available for irrigation purposes. We thank Mr. Sloot for his interest in reclaimed service and will contact Mr. Sloot when reclaimed water becomes available in the very near future.

In addition, Mr. Sloot had a request for an itemized bill statement. All customers, regardless of payment method, receive a monthly itemized billing statement notifying them of the automatic withdrawal amount.
