Dear Mr. Gorayeb:

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The Commission received your check for the \$6 past due penalty and interest charges for late payment of the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee. As my March 12th letter stated, companies holding certificates have a choice when requesting voluntary cancellation - they can either pay the current year's fee (\$50) or provide a date certain when it would be paid. Your note on the bottom of my letter did not provide that date nor was payment received.

The 2003 fee is due by January 30, 2004. You may either send me a note advising the company will pay the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee by the due date of January 30, 2004, or you can send a check for the minimum \$50 fee.

If the 2003 payment or statement of intent and date to pay the 2003 fee is not received by April 9, 2003, an enforcement docket may be opened for violation of Commission rules. If FJ Communications' certificate is cancelled, any unpaid fees will be turned over to collections.
