Dear Mr. Young and Mr. Erwin:

By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Orlando Utilities Commission please provide responses to the following data requests.

- 1) Please identify all transfers of facilities, facility purchases, and new facilities, that are necessary to implement the proposed retail territorial boundaries modifications in each of the five areas proposed for modification. If facilities are to be transferred, purchased or constructed, please include a proposed timetable for completing each of the necessary activities.
- 2) Will the end-use facilities of all existing customers of either utility be located wholly within their designated service area upon Commission approval of the addendum to the territorial agreement? If no, provide the following:
 - a. Number of current customers whose end-use facilities will not be located wholly within the Company's designated service area upon Commission approval of the proposed addendum.
 - b. Customer class of each such customer.
 - c. A map detailing the location of each such customer.


