In Order No. PSC-03-0480-PCO-WS, issued on April 11, 2003, the Commission ordered that the above referenced docket remain open to allow Florida Public Utility Company (FPUC) time to either revise its tariff or file a transfer application pursuant to Rule 25-30.037(4), Florida Administrative Code. The order went on to say that if FPUC sold its water division to the City of Fernandina Beach, the docket shall be closed administratively once the transfer application is filed and a new docket opened to process the transfer application.

On April 1, 2003, the Commission received a joint application for transfer of facilities of FPUC (Fernandina Beach Division) in Nassau County to the City of Fernandina Beach, and cancellation of Certificate No. 001-W. This application will be processed through Docket No. 030305-WU. Since the application for transfer has been filed and a new docket opened to process the transfer, staff believes that Order No. PSC-03-0480-PCO-WS, has been complied with. Therefore, it is recommended that Docket No. 020831-WS, be closed.
