The application filed in this docket has been reviewed, and there are some deficiencies in the filing. The items needing correction are delineated below.

- The territory description includes an area referred to as Tract B of 1. Dalton Woods. The description of Tract B refers to a plat book and page description. This description is not adequate, and instead must refer to section, township and range. See Rule 25-30.030(3)(e), Florida Administrative Code, (F.A.C.).
- 2. Pursuant to Section 25-30.036(3)(f), F.A.C., a map showing the proposed lines to be included in Dalton Woods is needed.
- 3. Exhibit H states that an application permit has been filed with the Department of Environmental Protection to modify the well pump. This permit number and date should be filed as a late-filed exhibit once it is received.
- 4. The number of the most recent order of the Commission establishing or changing the applicant's rates and charges was not provided. See Rule 25-30.030(3)(q), F.A.C.
- 5. An affidavit that the utility has tariffs and annual reports on file with the Commission, while mentioned on page 6 of the application as being "Exhibit O", cannot be found in the filing. See Rule 25-30.030(3)(r), F.A.C.

- 6. Exhibit M, the affidavit that notice of the application was given in accordance with Rule 25-30.030(2) and (5), F. A. C., is presumed to be a late-filed exhibit, since it is not contained in the application. The affidavit should be filed after the noticing is completed.
- 7. Exhibit N, the affidavit that notice of the application was published in the newspaper of general circulation, as required by Rule 25-30.030(7), F. A. C., is presumed to be a late-filed exhibit, since it is not contained in the application. The affidavit should be filed after the noticing is completed.
- 8. Please also provide a copy of the list of utilities noticed, as required by Rule 25-30.030(8), F. A. C.
