On November 26, 2002, the Commission issued Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order No. PSC-02-1653-PAA-TI in Docket No. 020724-TI approving Optical Telephone Corporation's proposal for refund of overcharges assessed on intrastate calls made using one plus service. Optical Telephone Corporation completed the refunds to its Florida customers that could be located on December 30, 2002. On April 8, 2003, it submitted its refund report with a check for \$1,691.69, the amount that was determined to be unrefundable. I have reviewed Optical Telephone Corporation's final report.
