- 14. Admit that Rule 25-4.118 was promulgated by the Commission. The rule speaks for itself.

- 16. Denied. AT&T makes itself "unavailable" when it refuses to pay for lawful past due access charges.
- 17. Admit that AT&T was billed for access charges. Deny that the invoices had any defects. Supra provided AT&T 55 days in which to review the invoices. This was more than enough time to review the Customer Detail Records submitted to AT&T on December 20, 2002.
- 18. Admit that on January 8, 2003, Supra sent a letter to AT&T informing them of what actions Supra would take if AT&T continued to refuse to pay its bills. Admit that on January 22, 2003, Supra filed an adversarial proceeding before the Bankruptcy court. Admit that on January 29, 2003, 42 days after receiving the Customer Detailed Records requested by AT&T, Supra sent out courtesy letters to Supra's own customers who also utilized AT&T for long distance to inform them of AT&T continued refusal to pay for lawful past due access charges. The remainder of the paragraph is denied.
