APPLICATION OF QWEST COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION AND QWEST INTERPRISE AMERICA, INC. FOR APPROVAL OF THE DISCONTINUANCE OF THE BUNDLED DSL INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE

Pursuant to Sections 25-24.474 and 25-24.820 of the Florida Administrative Code, Qwest Communications Corporation and Qwest Interprise America, Inc. (collectively "Qwest" and "Applicants") hereby submits this Application to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for approval of the discontinuance of Qwest's bundled digital subscriber line ("DSL") Internet access service in Florida, and for all other related relief that may be required to fulfill the intents and purposes of this Application.

I. IDENTIFICATION OF APPLICANTS

Applicants are Delaware corporations with principal offices and place of business located at 1801 California, Suite 5100, Denver, Colorado 80202. Applicants also have authorizations to transact business in Florida and operate as providers of switched local exchange service and exchange access service in Florida. Copies of Qwest's Certificates of Incorporation, registrations with the Florida Secretary of State and the authorizations to provide telecommunications services within the State of Florida, as granted in Commission Docket Nos. PSC-98-1873-TX and PSC-93-1054-TI, are already on file with the Commission and incorporated herein for all purposes. As described in the documentation, Applicants are a direct,

wholly-owned subsidiary of Qwest Services Corporation, which in turn, is a direct, wholly-owned subsidiary of Qwest Communications International Inc.

II. COMPLIANCE WITH SECTIONS 25-24.474 AND 25-24.820

(a) PAYMENT OF REGULATORY ASSESSMENT FEE

Qwest fully intends to satisfy the requirement to submit and pay a regulatory assessment fee as appropriate, when it becomes due on January 31, 2004.

(b) PURPOSE FOR THE DISCONTINUANCE

On April 11, 2003, Applicants submitted a letter notifying the Commission of an agreement reached with Covad Communications Company on March 19, 2003, under which Qwest agreed to sell to Covad the customer base for its bundled DSL Internet access service in various states including Florida (the "Transaction"). The Transaction is set to close upon the satisfaction or waiver of all obligations from any federal, state, local and non-U.S. regulatory body required for the completion of the Transaction, including the appropriate notification of this Commission and the customers in Florida.

Upon the consummation of the proposed Transaction, Applicants will have sold the customer base for the bundled DSL Internet access service in Florida. Selling the customer base shall effect the discontinuance of this service to the public. In accordance with Sections 25-24.474 and 25-24.820 of the Florida Administrative Code, Applicants request that the Commission issue the appropriate certificate for discontinuance of the bundled DSL Internet access service in Florida.

(c) TREATMENT OF CUSTOMER DEPOSIT AND FINAL BILLS

The approval of this Application will have no impact on the deposits or final bills of any Florida customer. Initially, once the migration of the customers of Qwest's bundled DSL Internet access service to Covad is complete, Qwest will have no customers of this service in Florida for which customer deposits or final bills might be an issue. Regardless, Qwest never required any customers of its bundled DSL Internet access service to pay deposits, therefore the discontinuance of this service would require no action with regard to customer deposits.

(d) PROOF OF CUSTOMER NOTICE

Applicants will provide notification to the customers of the bundled DSL Internet access service in the context of the Transaction with Covad, pursuant to the guidelines of the Federal Communications Commission. A copy of the notice is attached as Exhibit A. Upon providing this notification, and the migration of these customers, there will be no other customers of the bundled DSL Internet Access service for Qwest to provide notification of the discontinuance of this service. Accordingly, Applicants request, to the extent required, that the Commission deem inapplicable or waive any applicable statutory or regulatory subscriber authorization provisions regarding individual customer consent to assignment of accounts in connection with this Application.

III. APPLICANTS' CONTINUED PLANS OF OPERATION

Though no longer providing bundled DSL Internet access service, Applicants remain dedicated to providing reliable telecommunications services to customers in Florida pursuant to Qwest's certifications. As indicated in the April 11th letter, the Transaction between Qwest and Covad will result in no transfer, modification or cancellation of any existing certificates, or the issuance of any new certificates. Furthermore, Applicants do not offer the bundled DSL Internet

access service being provided to these customers through a Florida state tariff, therefore the

Transaction will result in no changes or modifications to Qwest's existing Florida state tariffs.

Applicants, therefore, intend to maintain all existing authorities to provide telecommunications

service in Florida.
