However, rather than resorting to dueling affidavits which might foster additional affidavits, we would simply urge the Commission to focus on the bottom line equities in this controversy. The key point here is the undisputed fact that The Links subdivision received lighting services and has yet to pay for those services despite having been billed. The benefit the subdivision received should not be subsidized by Tampa Electric or borne by the general body of Tampa Electric's customers.
