## GULF POWER COMPANY'S UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 1.46 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), Respondent Gulf Power Company, without waiving any of its arguments or defenses, respectfully requests that the FCC grant it an extension of ten (10) days to file a Petition for Reconsideration of the Memorandum Opinion and Order released by the Chief of the Enforcement Bureau of the FCC and effective on May 13, 2003 in the abovecaptioned proceeding ("Order"). Counsel for the Respondent has consulted with counsel for Complainants and is authorized to state that Complainants consent to this request.

Good cause exists to grant this request for an extension of ten (10) days. Due to the press of business, especially business relating to a variety of pole attachment matters, Respondent and

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counsel for Respondent have encountered scheduling conflicts during their preparation of the appropriate pleadings and, thus, need additional time to finalize their filing. Specifically, in addition to other unrelated matters, counsel for Respondent are engaged in preparing filings in other pole attachment cases, and they traveled to and attended the outreach session on pole attachment complaint proceedings held by the Market Disputes Resolution Division of the Enforcement Bureau on June 4, 2003.

WHEREFORE, Respondent Gulf Power Company respectfully requests that the FCC enter an Order extending the deadline to file a Petition for Reconsideration of the Enforcement Bureau's Order until June 21, 2003 (which date falls on a Saturday, resulting in a filing date of no later than June 23, 2003).
