

ISSUE 2: Should the Commission direct staff to administratively deny incomplete or inaccurate telecommunications applications in the future in the manner consistent with proposed Section 2.07.C.20 of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM)?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should direct staff to administratively deny all incomplete or inaccurate telecommunications applications in the future in the manner consistent with proposed Section 2.07.C.20 of the APM. If the Commission approves staff's recommendation in Issue 2, Section 2.07.C.20 of the APM should be updated as reflected in Attachment A of staff's June 5, 2003 memorandum.
