ISSUE 2: Should the scrivener errors in the territory description be corrected?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The scrivener errors described in staff's analysis should be corrected as shown in Attachment A of staff's June 5, 2003 memorandum. In addition, within 90 days from the date of the order approving the transfer, the utility should be required to file revised water and wastewater territory descriptions, consolidated territory maps, and revised tariff sheets. Upon verification that the revised territory descriptions accurately reflect the utility's approved service territory, staff should be given the authority to issue an administrative order in this docket approving the revised territory descriptions.

ISSUE 3: Should the existing rates and charges for the utility be continued?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The rates and charges approved for the utility should be continued. The tariff filing reflecting the change in majority control should be approved and effective for services rendered or connections made on or after the stamped approval date.

ISSUE 4: Should the docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No. The docket should remain open pending receipt of revised water and wastewater territory descriptions, composite territory maps, and revised tariff sheets. Upon verification that the revised territory descriptions accurately reflect the utility's approved service territory, staff should be given the authority to issue an administrative order in this docket approving the revised territory descriptions and closing the docket.
