Dear Ms. Litwinetz:

On March 18th, the Commission received a letter requesting cancellation of the company's IXC certificate. On March 19th, I wrote you and explained that before I could recommend a voluntary cancellation, the company had to pay the \$6 penalty and interest balance for late payment of the 1999 and 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fees and either pay the 2003 fee or provide a date certain it would be paid. As of this date, we have not received a response.

The alternative to a voluntary cancellation is an involuntary cancellation. This means that a company's certificate is cancelled on the Commission's own motion for a rule or order violation. Any unpaid fees are turned over to collections.

Although the company has requested cancellation, it has not complied with Rule 25-24.474, Florida Administrative Code. A copy of that rule was included with my March 19th letter. Please let me know by May 30th how the company wishes to proceed. If I do not hear from you by that date, I will have no choice but to go forward with an involuntary cancellation. Let me know if you have any questions or wish to discuss this. Thanks.

This letter is to inform your agency/department that Telecommunications Cooperative Network, Inc. ("TCN") ceased operating in FLORIDA as of December 31, 2002 and has no intention of resuming operations in your jurisdiction. The purpose of this letter is to initiate any final actions required to wrap-up our previous operations and close any accounts or certificates of authority.

**1. Ceased Operations**

As of December 31, 2002, TCN ceased operating in FLORIDA. TCN has no intention of resuming operations in FLORIDA at any time in the future. TCN understands that if TCN wishes to re-enter FLORIDA that it will be required to initiate new regulatory actions.

**2. No Harm to Consumers**

During the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2002, TCN endeavored to wrap up all of its customer activity in FLORIDA. It is our understanding that all customers for long-distance services in FLORIDA have been terminated and that there are no open disputes or problems.

**3. Request to Terminate Certification/Regulated Status/Authority to do Business**

Because TCN, effective December 31, 2002, ceased operations in FLORIDA, TCN hereby requests that your agency terminate any and all certifications, registrations, account holding activity, authority to do business, or any other regulated status that TCN may have previously enjoyed.

TCN was merely a long-distance reseller in FLORIDA. At no time in TCN's corporate existence did TCN own or lease plant, property or equipment in FLORIDA.


