- 1. The CLEC Parties have today filed their Notice of Partial Dismissal of the portion of the complaint which sought relief from BellSouth's practice of refusing to provide FastAccess service to end-users served by CLECs via UNE-L.
- 2. The partial dismissal was taken to narrow the issues in dispute and to simplify the upcoming hearing. The partial dismissal will allow the parties to focus only issues related to the provision of FastAccess service to end-users served by CLECs via the UNE platform (UNE-P).
- 3. In light of this partial dismissal, testimony and discussion related to the provision of FastAccess service to end-users who are served via UNE-L is no longer relevant to any of the issues to be resolved by the Commission in this docket. BellSouth should therefore be precluded
