
In compliance with the Annual Reporting requirements of the Territorial Agreement between Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Clay") and Gainesville Regional Utilities, ("GRU") approved by the Commission on August 9, 2002, GRU and Clay hereby jointly report as follows:

1. No interim services are being rendered by either GRU or Clay.
2. No transfers have been completed.
3. The respective engineering staff of the parties have agreed on a mid-November, 2003, target date for the completion of the contemplated transfer. Toward that end the parties have exchanged customer lists and facilities maps and are cooperatively engaged in the inventory of the affected physical plant.
4. No facilities on either Archer Road or Williston Road have been removed, nor will such facilities be removed until after the transfer to customers between Clay and GRU.


