Our client, Park Manor Waterworks, Inc. (the "Company"), has entered into an Agreement for Purchase and Sale of its water and wastewater assets to Orange County, Florida (the "County"). The closing is conditioned upon the Company obtaining advance approval from the Public Service Commission (the "Commission"). While Commission approval of the application is, of course, a matter of statutory right, the County has heretofore declined to waive or modify that precondition, notwithstanding the Governor's July 15, 2003, veto of Senate Bill 140.

We have therefore requested expedited issuance of the Commission order approving the transfer, in advance of closing. In response, Commission Staff has conveyed concerns regarding the Commission's ability to secure payment of regulatory assessment fees from the former owner of a transferred utility, and requested advance payment of the fees accrued through closing.

Given substantial expenditures on plant repairs required in advance of closing, our client does not have the liquidity to remit such fees (which are technically due on or before March 31, 2004) at this time. However, in an attempt to alleviate Staff's concerns, enclosed herewith please find the Company's instructions to the Closing Agent directing payment of regulatory assessment fees from the sales proceeds to be received at closing. The estimation of the amount of regulatory assessment fees in those instructions was calculated under the assumption of an August 31, 2003 closing date.
