FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Cox Florida Telcom, L.P. ("Cox"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), and Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes (2002), hereby files this Request for Confidential Classification for the answer to Item No. 5 in Cox's response to the Commission Staff's 2003 Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Data Request.

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(4)(a), F.A.C., attached hereto are one copy of the data response being submitted, with the information for which Cox is seeking confidential classification highlighted, and two copies of the redacted data response. The response does not have line numbers, but the highlighted information is found at the second through the fourth lines on page 2 of Cox's response.

The data sought, and provided by Cox in the unredacted data response, is the number of broadband service lines, by type, over which Cox or any of Cox's affiliates are providing broadband service in Florida. This information is confidential, proprietary business information within the scope of Section


364.183(1), Florida Statutes (2002), for the following reasons.

- a. The information is owned and controlled by Cox.
- b. The information is intended to be and is treated by Cox as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to Cox's and its affiliates' business operations by providing competitively sensitive information regarding the extent of Cox's affiliates' operations in Florida to the universe of Cox's competitors.
- c. The subject information has not been disclosed except that, pursuant to the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, the information has been disclosed on Cox's Form 477. When reported on the Form 477, the information was claimed as confidential by Cox and has been accordingly treated as confidential by the FCC.
- d. The information relates to Cox's and its affiliates' competitive interests and, as noted above, the disclosure of the information would impair Cox's and its affiliates' business operations by providing competitively sensitive information regarding the extent of Cox's affiliates' operations in Florida to the universe of Cox's competitors.

Pursuant to Section 364.183(4), Florida Statutes, Cox respectfully requests that the subject information be classified as confidential and handled accordingly by the Commission until the information is either returned or for a period of 18 months as allowed by the statute.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Cox Florida Telcom, L.P. respectfully requests that the Commission grant confidential classification to Cox's response to Item No. 5 in the Commission Staff's 2003 Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Data Request.
