The Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) is due by January 30th of each year for the preceding calendar year and is .0015% of a company's intrastate revenues, or \$50.00, whichever is greater. Our records show that the 2002 RAF return form was mailed to us showing revenues in the amount of -\$27,318, but payment for the minimum fee was not included. Since payment is late, statutory penalty and interest charges are applicable.

In addition to the 2002 RAF, plus penalty and interest charges, the company has a small past due balance in the amount of \$7.00 for late payment of prior years' RAFs that must also be paid. If payment is postmarked by May 30th, this means the company owes a total of \$69 (\$7 for prior years and for 2002 the amount is \$50 fee, \$10 penalty, \$2 interest). If payment is postmarked between May 31st and June 29th, this means the company owes a total of \$72)\$7.00 for prior years and for 2002 the amount is \$50.00 fee, \$12.50 penalty, \$2.50 interest). A copy of the 2002 RAF return form is enclosed, along with a breakdown of the past due amount.

If full payment, including penalty and interest charges, is not received by June 13, 2003, a docket will be established. Your company will be fined or your certificate cancelled if you do not respond. Please note that once a docket has been established, just paying the delinquent RAF amount will not prevent your certificate from being cancelled.

If you wish to cancel your certificate voluntarily and leave in good standing with the Commission, your company should pay the past due amount in full, comply with the requirements of Rule 25-24.514, Florida Administrative Code, copy enclosed, and either pay the 2003 RAF or provide a date certain it will be paid. Any unpaid RAFs, including penalty and interest charges, are turned over to collections.
