#### PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF NXX-X CODE DENIAL

MetroPCS, Inc. ("metroPCS"), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 5

52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Order FCC 00- 104, and
Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Order No. PSC-0 1 - T 873-PCOTL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator's ("NeuStar") denial of metroPCS's request for additional numbering resources in the Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte exchange. In support of this petition, metroPCS states:

#### **PARTIES**

- 1. metroPCS is a corporation organized and formed under the laws of the State of Florida and a Wireless Carrier Company regulated by the Commission and authorized to provide local exchange telecommunications arid InterLata and IntraLata toll telecommunications in the State of Florida.
- 2. NeuStar is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. See 47 C.F.R. § 52.20(d).

### JURISDICTION

3. The Commission has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Industry

Numbering Committees (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). This provision provides that a carrier may challenge NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority.

## BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

- 4. On March 31, 2000, the FCC issued Order No. 00-104 ("FCC 00-104" or the "Order") in the Numbering Resource Optimization docket (Docket No. 99-200). The goal of FCC 00-104 was to implement uniform standards governing requests for telephone numbering resources in order to increase efficiency in the use of telephone numbers and to avoid further exhaustion of telephone numbers under the NANP.
- 5. Among other things, FCC 00-1 04 adopted a revised standard for assessing a carrier's need for numbering resources by requiring rate center based utilization rates to be reported to NANPA. FCC Order at \$105. The FCC further required that, to qualify for access to new numbering resources, applicants must establish that existing numbering inventory within the applicant's rate center will be exhausted within six months of the application. Prior to the ruling, the Central Office Code Assignment Guidelines, used by the industry and NANPA to make code assignments, required the applicant's existing number inventory within the applicant's serving switch to exhaust within a specific months-to-exhaust ("MTE") of the code application in order for a code to be assigned or for the carrier to prove that it was unable to meet a specific customer's request with its current inventory of numbers. The FCC stated that the shift to a "rate center" basis for determining the need for new numbering resources was intended to "more accurately reflect how numbering

resources are assigned" and to allow "carriers to obtain numbering resources in response to specific customer demands." FCC Order at 105. ¶ 2

- 6. On December 29, 2000, the FCC also released FCC 00-429, which reaffirmed FCC 00-104 and also required carriers to also meet 'a 60 percent initial utilization threshold. FCC 00-429 at ¶ 26. Based on these two FCC orders, carriers are required to meet a six MTE criteria as well as a utilization threshold on a rate center/exchange basis in order to be granted additional numbering resources. Id. ¶29.
- 7. In FCC 00-104, the FCC directed the industry and the Pooling Administrator to comply with the INC Pooling Guidelines. FCC 1 1 104 ¶ 83.

  Pursuant to the INC Guidelines, in order to obtain thousand-block allocations, the carrier must demonstrate that its existing numbering resources for the rate center will exhaust within six (6) months and also have a utilization of 60 percent for the specific rate center. See INC Guidelines Section 4.3(d) and Appendix 3. These requirements are known as the six (6) months-to-exhaust ("MTE") and utilization threshold.
- 8. Since the beginning of this year, metroPCS has submitted several requests for additional numbering resources to North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA") and NeuStar for assignment of additional numbering resources to meet the demands of its customers in several Florida exchanges, including Miami and North Dade.
- 9. metroPCS has completed these applications in accordance with INC guidelines and filled out the necessary Months-to-Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheets as required.

- 10. metroPCS has utilized mechanisms such as number pooling to manage its numbering resources in the most efficient manner. However, as the Commission is well aware, in some circumstances, metroPCS has been required to petition the Commission for relief.
- 11. As for this request for additional numbering resources for the Fort Myers,

  Naples and Port Charlotte exchange, metroPCS states the following:
- 12. The Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte exchanges consists of one(1) central office and (1) switch, Fort Myers (FTMYFLDZ2MD).
- 13. On August 22, 2003, metroPCS requested additional numbering resources from NeuStar for the Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte (FTMYFLDZ2MD) switch. Specifically, metroPCS requested sixteen 1,000 consecutive number block to increase the months to exhaust of this switch to 6 months.
- 14. At the time of the code request, the Fort Myers exchange had a MTE of 2166, and a utilization of 0.040%'
- 15. On August 22, 2003, NeuStar denied metroPCS's request for additional numbering resources because metroPCS had not met the rate center based on utilization criteria. Attached to this Petition is the MTE and utilization rate for each switch in the Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte exchange.
- 16. metroPCS's request for additional numbering resources to provide additional numbering resources for the Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte central office would not materially impact exhaustion of available numbers in the 239 and 941 area code.

- 17. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review NANPA's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).
- 18. Under earlier MTE procedures used by NANPA, waivers or exceptions were granted when customer hardships could be demonstrated or when the service provider's inventory did not have a block of sequential numbers large enough to meet the customer's specific request. Under existing procedures, NeuStar nor NANPA looks at the number of MTE and utilization for the entire rate center without any exceptions. The current process is arbitrary and results in (1) decisions contrary to the public interest and welfare of consumers in the State of Florida; and (2) decisions that do not necessarily promote the efficient use of telephone numbers.
- 19. Unfortunately, metroPCS's inability to obtain numbering resources in the above switch, which is necessary to meet its customers' numbering demands in multiswitch rate centers, will not be the last time metroPCS experiences this problem. metroPCS has a total of 18 rate centers in Florida. Some of the switches within these rate centers are already within or near the six MTE. metroPCS, however, believes that it will be unable to meet the six MTE threshold at the rate center level in all of these multi-switch rate centers, jeopardizing its ability to adequately comply with its carrier of last resort obligations.
- 20. metroPCS requests that the Commission's reverse NeuStar's decision to withhold numbering resources from metroPCS on the following grounds:

- (a) NeuStar's denial of numbering resources to metroPCS interferes with metroPCS's ability to serve its customers within the State of Florida.
- (b) As a result of NeuStar's denial of metroPCS's request for additional numbering resources, metroPCS will be unable to provide telecommunications services to its customers as required under Florida law.

## WHEREFORE, metroPCS requests:

- The Commission review the decision of NeuStar to deny metroPCS's
  request for additional numbering resources for the Fort Myers, Naples and Port
  Charlotte exchange
- 2. The Commission direct NeuStar to provide the requested numbering resources for the Fort Myers, Naples and Port Charlotte exchange as discussed above. Respectfully submitted this 29th day of August, 2003.

MetroPCS will be launching in the west coast on October 1, 2003. Right now, we only have the 0 block for each rate center and they are not being utilized at this time (Naples, Fort Myers & Port Charlotte). When we launch, we estimate that metroPCS will need about 35k within the next 6 to 12 months in all three rate centers combined. When I'm at the MTE part in PAS, my Month's to Exhaust is being met, but the utilization is not. I spoke to Gary Zahn at Neustar and he advised me to speak with you. Also what was explained to me is that a waiver is sometimes issued when an OCN cannot meet the Utilization part, but the MTE is met. Please let me know what I can do. Thank you for your assistance.

An update...the Commission unanimously approved staff's recommendation at agenda. A proposed agency action (PAA) order should be issued today. The PAA allows a 21-day protest period whereby any significantly affected persons can protest the order. If no protests are received after the 21-day period, a consummating order is issued finalizing the Commission decision.

As recommended in the order, CMRS carriers will be allowed to avail themselves of the expedited process set up for code denials. I am attaching a copy of Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, issued October 4, 2001, which outlines the code denial process for 10,000 block code denials. I am also attaching a copy of Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, issued March 15, 2002, which includes 1,000 block code denials in the expedited process.




