

**PROGRESS ENERGY FLORIDA' PETITION FOR APPROVAL  
OF ENVIRONMENTAL COST RECOVERY TRUE-UP AND  
ENVIRONMENTAL COST RECOVERY FACTORS FOR  
THE PERIOD JANUARY 2004 to DECEMBER 2004**

Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF" or "the Company"), hereby petitions for approval of its environmental cost recovery true-up and proposed environmental cost recovery factors for the period January 2004 to December 2004. In support of this Petition, PEF states:

1. As explained in the pre-filed testimony and exhibits of Javier Portuondo, PEF's total true-up applicable for this period is an under-recovery of \$10,858,968. This consists of the final true-up under-recovery of \$38,833 for the period from October 1 through December 31, 2002 and an estimated true-up under-recovery of \$10,820,135 for the current period of January 2003 through December 2003. The detailed calculation supporting the estimated true-up was provided on *revised* Forms 42-1E through 42-8E of Exhibit No. (JP-1) filed with the Commission on September 5, 2003.

2. As explained in Mr. Portuondo's testimony of September 8, 2003 and shown in Form 42-1P of Exhibit No. \_\_ (JP-2), the total projected jurisdictional capital and O&M costs for the period January 2004 to December 2004 are \$10,227,719.

3. PEF's proposed Environmental Cost Recovery (ECR) factors for the period January 2004 to December 2004, which are designed to recover the 2002 final true-up, the


estimated 2003 true-up, and projected 2004 costs, are presented for the Commission's review and approval in Mr. Portuondo's testimony of September 8, 2003. The ECR factors were calculated as shown on Forms 42-6P and 42-7P of Exhibit \_\_ (JP-2) to Mr. Portuondo's testimony.

4. The environmental cost recovery true-up and proposed environmental cost recovery factors presented in Mr. Portuondo's testimony and exhibits are consistent with the provisions of Section 366.8255, Florida Statutes, and with prior rulings by the Commission.

WHEREFORE, Progress Energy Florida, Inc., respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Company's environmental cost recovery true-up and proposed environmental cost recovery factors for the period January 2004 through December 2004 as set forth in the testimony and supporting exhibit of Javier Portuondo filed on September 8, 2004 .

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
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
