COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: My name is Commissioner Rudolph Bradley, and I'm here for the prehearing, Docket Number 021206-TC in reference to Commercial PayFon, Inc. I would now like to call this prehearing conference to order. Could I have the notice read, please.

MR. TEITZMAN: Pursuant to notice issued August 28th, 2003, this time and place has been set for a prehearing conference in Docket Number 021206-TC, compliance investigation of Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc., for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.019, Florida Administrative Code, records and reports in general.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Thank you. Let's take appearances, please.

MR. TEITZMAN: Adam Teitzman on behalf of the Florida Public Service Commission.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Okay. On behalf of Commercial PayFon? Is anyone present?

MR. TEITZMAN: Commissioner, no one is present this morning from Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Okay. Then, just for the record, I need to ask a couple of questions. Number one, are there any representatives, and you have said no, but just for the record I'm going to read these questions. Are there any representatives of Commercial PayFon, Inc., present? The

Staff, have you had any contact with Commercial PayFon about their participation at this prehearing?

MR. TEITZMAN: Staff has made several attempts to contact a representative of Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc., including sending the prehearing and hearing notice by certified mail. On Friday, staff received the receipt on the certified mail signed by Mr. Hozae Milton of Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc., so they were on notice of today's prehearing.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: So they are aware of this hearing this morning?

MR. TEITZMAN: That is correct.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Okay. Thank you. I would like to, again, note for the record that no representative of Commercial PayFon, Inc., is present as required by the order establishing procedure. At this time, are there any preliminary matters by any of the parties?

And at this point, additionally, staff would also request continuance of the hearing.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Fine. Is there anything else to come before the prehearing officer at this time?

MR. TEITZMAN: No, there is not.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Again, let me ask -- let me make this statement. If there is no representative from Commercial PayFon -- I'm sorry, if no representative from Commercial PayFon appears, Staff, as you said, you will ask to continue and not cancel the hearing. I will grant that for September 24th, and at that time you will make your recommendation.

MR. TEITZMAN: Commissioner, staff would like to bring it to the next available agenda, the recommendation.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: And what date will that be?

MR. TEITZMAN: I don't have a date right now, but -- September 30th, Commissioner.

COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: September 30th? Okay, so granted.

Are there any other matters that we need to give consideration to today, this morning? MR. TEITZMAN: I believe that would be all, Commissioner. COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Let me thank you all for your participation at this prehearing conference, and the conference is adjourned. MR. TEITZMAN: Thank you, Commissioner. COMMISSIONER BRADLEY: Thank you. (The prehearing concluded at 9:39 a.m.)
