RE: Docket No. 030613-TA - Cancellation by Florida Public Service Commission of AAV Certificate No. 2961 issued to Commercial Communications Systems, Inc. for violation of Rule 25-4.0161, F.A.C., Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies.

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission grant Commercial Communications Systems, Inc. a voluntary cancellation of AAV Certificate No. 2961?

RECOMMENDATION: The Commission should not grant the company a voluntary cancellation of its AAV certificate. The Commission should cancel the company's AAV Certificate No. 2961 on its own motion, effective July 11, 2003. The collection of the past due fees should be referred to the Florida Department of Financial Services for further collection efforts. If the certificate is cancelled in accordance with the Commission's Order from this recommendation, the company should be required to immediately cease and desist providing alternative access vendor service in Florida.
