- 1. On August 26, 2003, BellSouth filed its response to Florida Public Service Commission Staff's ("Staff") Second Interrogatories (Item Nos. 35 through 98) in this docket. BellSouth's response to Interrogatory Nos. 68 and 87 as well as the attachment to BellSouth's response to Interrogatory No. 46 include confidential business information that is considered proprietary to BellSouth.
- 2. BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential
 Classification because the information contained in the attachment BellSouth provided to
 respond to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories, Request No. 46 as well as responses to
 Interrogatory Nos. 68 and 87 include confidential, proprietary information utilized by
