PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the Petition of Cargill Fertilizer, Inc. for permanent approval of self-service wheeling to, from, and between points within Tampa Electric Company's service area and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on October 6, 2003. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.
