- 3. The Applicant has not been able to locate the original certificate and requests a replacement certificate. A copy of original Wastewater Certificate No. 379-S is attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 4. The Applicant is making this Application because the Applicant has been providing, and wishes to continue to provide, wastewater service to the Extension Area. The Extension Area is adjacent to its existing certificated wastewater service area.
- 5. To the best of Applicant's knowledge, the provision by the Applicant of wastewater service to the Extension Area is consistent with the wastewater section of the Seminole County Comprehensive Plan at the time this Application is filed, as approved by the Department of Community Affairs.
- 6. Applicant is an established utility. Documentary evidence of its ownership of the land on which its wastewater plant is constructed will be provided as Late Filed Exhibit "C".
- 7. A map of the territory to be served, using township, range and section references, is attached as Exhibit "D". A full-sized map will be provided to Commission Staff.
- 8. The approval of this Application is in the public interest because there is a need for wastewater service to the Extension Area; the Applicant has been providing wastewater service to the Extension Area; and it is in the public interest for the Applicant, as the utility whose certificated wastewater service

area adjoins the Extension Area, to continue to provide such service.

- 9. The existing lines and treatment facilities currently serving the Applicant's existing certificated wastewater service area have sufficient capacity to serve the Extension Area. The Applicant is providing wastewater service in the Extension Area to one customer, the Oviedo Presbyterian Church. The Applicant's current wastewater systems serving the existing certificated service area and the Extension Areas have sufficient capacity to serve the existing and proposed wastewater service area.
- 10. The amendment of the Applicant's wastewater certificate to include the Extension Area within its certificated wastewater service area will not interrupt, curtail or otherwise affect the provision of wastewater service to existing customers.
- 11. The inclusion of the Extension Area within the Applicant's certificated wastewater service area will not have any impact on the Applicant's rates or service availability charges. Interim rates for the Applicant were established by the Commission in Order No. PSC-03-0380-PCO-SU. Final rates are expected to be set in November, 2003.
- 12. The Applicant is an established utility and has both the financial and technical ability to render reasonably sufficient, adequate and efficient service. A copy of the most recent Financial Statements from the Applicant's 2002 Annual Report will

be provided as Late File Exhibit "E"

- 13. With respect to the Applicant's technical ability, attached as Exhibit "F" is a schedule listing the operators and their license numbers. There are no outstanding Consent Orders or Notices of Violation from DEP.
- 14. Attached as Exhibit "G" to this Application are the original and two copies of the revised tariff sheets reflecting the inclusion of the Extension Area. Copies of the revised tariff sheets are attached to each copy of the Application.
- 16. Attached as Exhibit "H" is an affidavit that the notice of actual application was given in accordance with Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail to the following:
 - (1) the governing body of the municipality, county or counties in which the system or territory proposed to be served is located;
 - that holds a certificate granted by the Public Service Commission and that is located within the county in which the utility or the territory proposed to be served is located;
 - (3) if any portion of the proposed territory is within one mile of a county boundary, the utility shall notice the privately owned utilities located in the

- bordering counties and holding a certificate granted by the Commission;
- (4) the regional planning council;
- (5) the Office of Public Counsel;
- (6) the Public Service Commission's Director of Records and Reporting;
- (7) the appropriate regional office of the Department of Environmental Protection; and
- (8) the appropriate water management district;
 Copies of the Notice and a list of entities noticed
 shall accompany the affidavit.
- 17. Late Filed Exhibit "I" will be the notice of actual application was given in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail or personal delivery to each property owner in the Extension Area.
- 18. Late Filed Exhibit "J" will be an affidavit that the notice of application was published once a week in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. A copy of the proof of publication will accompany the affidavit.
- 19. In response to Section 367.045(2)(c), Florida Statutes, attached hereto as Exhibit "K" is an Affidavit that the Applicant has on file with the PSC a tariff and current annual report.
 - 20. The Extension Area is currently serving 1 ERC. Pursuant

to Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code, the appropriate filing fee is \$100.00.



(OVERSIZED MAP)


