October Status Report Regarding Zellwood Station Cooperative

Transfer to Orange County

Dear Ms. Merchant:

Pursuant to our prior commitment, I am providing to you and all other parties in this proceeding our seventh status report of activities concerning the transfer of the water and sewer plants from Zellwood Station Cooperative to Orange County for the month of October:

- (1) Orange County has requested that the closing be moved back to the date set for in the contract, that is, January 15, 2004. This is based on two issues. First, a preliminary Level I Environmental Assessment Report found a potential contamination site.

 Apparently, some type of underground tank was previously installed on a portion of the property being conveyed (our best information is that the tank was removed in 1990 prior to the Co-Op's ownership). This matter is currently being addressed pursuant to the contract by means of a Level II Environmental Assessment. The second issue relates to discussions with the St. Johns River Water Management District. A copy of the latest communication with a punch list of final items for the closing of this transaction is enclosed as Exhibit "A".
- (2) Zellwood has filed its application to transfer the various system assets to Orange County and the Zellwood Community Association with the Florida Public Service Commission. The application was filed in July, 2003 and supplemental information has been sent to the PSC staff immediately when requested.

(3) Orange County and the St. Johns River Water Management District met on October 8, 2003, to resolve all outstanding issues. With one exception, all issues have been resolved with the Water Management District related to issuance of the necessary Consumptive Use Permit to consummate the transaction. This issue relates to the projections of need for groundwater withdrawals, and is a topic currently being discussed between the District, Zellwood, and Orange County. Resolution of this issue is expected to occur in November.
