This letter addresses the tariff matters we discussed relating to the Utility's tariff's which were filed in the above name change docket, and which you are currently reviewing for approval.

Enclosed as you requested are the Water Tariff Original Sheet No. 24.0 and the Wastewater Tariff Original Sheet No. 22.0, both addressing Service Availability Policy. The tariffs have been changed from stating "NA" to stating: "The utility system is at build-out and therefore there is no service availability policy." Water Tariff Original Sheet No. 23.0 is also enclosed, correcting a typographic error. These tariff sheets should replace the sheets filed with the application in the above-named docket.

Also enclosed as you requested is a copy of the customer notice of name change which was sent to the customers on September 19, 2003.

In response to your inquiry, my recollection is that the reason that the wastewater bill is located in the "electric" section of the customer bill is that the bill sent to customers by the billing company does not have a "sewer" section, but does have an unused "electric" section, so the billing company puts the wastewater bill component of the invoice in that unused section.
