BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, this Request For Specified Confidential Classification and states the following:

1. In a letter dated June 16, 2003, the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") requested that BellSouth provide Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier ("ILEC") data for the 2003 report on local competition. BellSouth provided certain information to Staff on July 31, 2003, August 8, 2003, August 11, 2003, August 13, 2003, August 14, 2003, August 18, 2003, August 21, 2003 and August 28, 2003.

2. On October 27, 2003, BellSouth provided its supplemental response regarding the Century Exchange, along with a Notice of Intent because its response contained confidential business information.

3. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth is now filing a Request for Specified Confidential Classification for its supplemental response regarding the Century Exchange because said response contains customer specific information that is considered confidential and proprietary to BellSouth. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.

4. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the information for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

5. Appended hereto as Attachment B are two copies of the requested documents with the confidential information deleted.

6. Appended hereto as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the documents including the material which is confidential and proprietary.


