Pierce Exchange (Ft. Pierce Main)

On December 2, 2003, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny a growth code located in the Fort Pierce Main (FTPRFLMADS0) switch. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL which, approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a specific customer in need of immediate numbering resources;
- The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to the potential 2) customer because of NeuStar's denial of numbering resources; and
- 3) The potential customer cannot obtain service from the provider of its choice because the carrier does not have numbers available to fulfill the customer's needs.

Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (December 23, 2003) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed one thousand consecutive number block to meet its customer's needs for 1,000 consecutive numbers in the range of NPA NXX-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 or 8.
