ITEM 3 DOCKET NO. 030415-TP - PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULES 25-4.110, CUSTOMER BILLING FOR LOCAL EXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANIES; 25-24.490, CUSTOMER RELATIONS, RULES INCORPORATED; 25-24.585, RULES, INCORPORATED; AND 25-24.845, CUSTOMER RELATIONS; RULES INCORPORATED, F.A.C.
