Jackie, just as a reminder, if a company pays the current year's RAF and requests cancellation of certificate by the due date of January 30, 2004, a docket can be opened to grant the voluntary cancellation with an effective date of December 31, 2003 (that way, they won't owe the 2004 RAF).
