On May 15, 2000, Florida Power and Light (FPL) filed with the Commission its Motion for Protective Order Regarding Confidential Information Required to be Filed as Part of True-Up Filing in Docket No. 000002-EI. The subject of FPL's request was Document No. 05989-00, filed on May 15, 2000. By Order No. PSC-00-2080-CFO-EG, issued November 1, 2000, the Commission granted FPL's Motion, and Document No. 05989-00 was deemed confidential for a period of 36 months.

On October 29, 2003, FPL filed its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification for Document No. 05989-00. The information that is the subject of FPL's request contains customer-specific information intended to support claimed energy savings in FPL's 2000 conservation adjustments. As such, that information is no longer needed by Commission to conduct its business. Accordingly, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(9)(b), Florida Administrative Code, Document No. 05989-00 should be returned to the company. Furthermore, upon the return of this information to the company, FPL's First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification, filed October 29, 2003, should be considered moot.
