Attached please find a letter claiming confidential and proprietary business information status for certain data submitted to this Commission under separate cover. On Monday, February 2, my client, Progress Telecom, LLC, mailed to this Commission its responses to the TRO CLEC Data Request that was propounded by Commission Staff in the above-captioned proceeding. Progress assembled these data in-house, and mailed them to the Commission via registered mail. We anticipate that the Commission will receive this filing in the immediate future.

At the time the response to the TRO CLEC Data Request was mailed, my client was unaware of its right to claim confidential treatment of the information it submitted. 
