Administration (NANPA) for the Sebastian Rate Center (Sebastian Main)

On February 17, 2004, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the Sebastian Main (SBSTFLMADS0) switch located in the Sebastian rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for NeuStar code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a switch in a non-pooling multiswitch rate center which has a months-to-exhaust of less than six months;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to customers because its supply of numbers is less than six months; and
- 3) Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier will run out of numbers within six months.


Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (March 9, 2004) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NANPA should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Sebastian Main Switch (SBSTFLMADSO), specifically, an NXX of ten thousand numbers, since this is not a pooling area.
