JOINT MOTION OF THE CITIZENS OF FLORIDA AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC., TO USE UNCLAIMED REFUNDS FOR THE PROMOTION OF LIFELINE AND LINKUP PROGRAMS

Pursuant to Rule 28-106.303, Florida Administrative Code, the Citizens of Florida (Citizens), through Harold McLean, Public Counsel, and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth Telecommunications) file this motion requesting the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) to authorize the use of unclaimed refunds in this proceeding for the promotion of Lifeline and LinkUp programs.

1. By Order no. PSC-01-1769-FOF-TL issued August 30, 2001, the Commission ordered BellSouth Telecommunications to refund all amounts collected through a restructured interest charge, with interest, to all affected customers. The order was silent about the treatment of unclaimed refunds. The Commission's order was affirmed by the Florida Supreme Court in *BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., v. Jacobs*, 834 So.2d 855 (Fla. 2002).

- 2. There is approximately \$2.9 million outstanding from the returned unpaid drafts and unrefunded amounts of less than \$1.00 per customer. Citizens and BellSouth Telecommunications believe that this money should be used to promote Lifeline and LinkUp programs in a manner consistent with the way these programs have been promoted pursuant to the settlement agreement between BellSouth Telecommunications and Citizens dated July 9, 2001, which was approved by this Commission by Order No. PSC01-1643-AS-TL issued on August 13, 2001.
- 3. Section 364.025, Florida Statutes (2003) states the Legislature's intent that universal service objectives be maintained after the local exchange market is opened to competitively provided services. These use of unclaimed refunds to promote Lifeline and Linkup programs will help to meet this objective. In addition, the importance of Lifeline and Linkup programs in meeting this objective is demonstrated by section 364.0252, Florida Statutes (2003), which states the Legislature's specific concern that consumers be informed concerning the availability of the Lifeline and LinkUp Programs for low-income households.
- 4, Citizens and BellSouth believe that the use of unclaimed refunds in this manner is consistent with the public interest and chapter 364, Florida Statutes.

Wherefore, Citizens and BellSouth Telecommunications urge the Commission to authorize the use of unclaimed refunds in this proceeding for the promotion of Lifeline and LinkUp programs, as described in this motion.
