shorten time and expedite the scheduling of the requested hearing and schedule a hearing for April 27, 2004 at 10:00 a.m. and states:

1. On April 9, 2004, the Trustee served the Motion by regular mail on all parties entitled to notice.

2. The settlement at issue in the Motion involves, in part, an obligation by the Trustee to pay Lamar \$100,000 pursuant to a stipulated settlement approved by this Court on October 30, 2002.

3. As the settlement involves, in part, a longstanding obligation of the Trustee to make payment to Lamar, the Trustee seeks an expedited hearing on the Motion on April 27, 2004 at 10:00 a.m.

4. If the Court grants the relief sought herein, the Trustee will serve the order shortening time and setting the expedited hearing, along with the Motion, by regular mail on all parties entitled to notice by a date to be determined by the Court.
