Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby serves Notice of its Intent to Seek Confidential Classification of the deposition transcripts and deposition exhibits of Dr. Robert L. Sansom, Dr. Anatoly Hochstein, Ms. Joann T. Wehle, Mr. Brent Dibner, Mr. Frederick J. Murrell, Ms. Paula M. Guletsky and Mr. Martin Duff, and says:

- 1. Depositions have been taken of each of the above-listed persons in this proceeding. In order to facilitate the Commission Staff's reliance on the deposition transcripts and exhibits of the above proponents, Tampa Electric this date is filing under a separate cover letter a single copy of the deponents' deposition transcripts and exhibits as a confidential document printed on yellow paper stock.
