By letter received February 27, 2004, Global NAPs, Inc filed a request for approval of interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement with ALLTEL Florida, Inc. On May 27, 2004, ALLTEL filed a revised agreement. By letter filed June 2, 2004, ALLTEL clarified that the agreement filed on May 27, 2004, is a correction to the February 27, 2004, agreement, not a new agreement. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was May 27, 2004.

Staff reviewed the revised agreement in this Docket on June 1, 2004. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual. Therefore, it has gone into effect by operation of law in accordance with Section 252(e)(4) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.)
