

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S NOTICE OF INTENT
TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, files this its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of the material contained in the company's "Final Dismantling Study – 2002" being filed this date under a separate cover letter. Tampa Electric is making the above material available for Staff's confidential review. This information is being provided in response to Staff's request, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

The Final Dismantling Study contains confidential proprietary business information the public disclosure of which could be very harmful not only to Tampa Electric, but also to the specialty demolition contractor whose cost information is detailed in the Dismantling Study.

It is requested that Staff takes steps to have the Final Dismantling Study returned to the undersigned prior the expiration of the 21-day temporary exemption set forth in the above-referenced rule, which would mean on or before Tuesday, July 6, 2004.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric submits the foregoing as its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of its Final Dismantling Study – 2002.


