Issue 1: Should the Commission approve Gulf Power Company's numeric conservation goals for the 2005 through 2014 period?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. The programs, assumptions, and evaluation methodology used by Gulf to develop its proposed numeric goals are reasonable and adequately meet the requirements of Rule 25-17.0021, Florida Administrative Code.
