<u>Issue 1</u>: Should the Commission approve Orlando Utilities Commission's numeric conservation goals for the 2005 through 2014 period?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. The programs, assumptions, and evaluation methodology used by OUC are reasonable and adequately meet the requirements of Rule 25-17.0021, Florida Administrative Code. OUC appropriately used the RIM test to determine the cost-effective level of achievable DSM goals, and found that none of the tested measures were cost-effective. Therefore, OUC's proposed numeric conservation goals of zero for the period 2005 through 2014 should be approved.

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<u>Issue 2</u>: Should the Commission acknowledge Orlando Utilities Commission's DSM Plan? <u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, OUC's numeric conservation goals will be set at zero and OUC should not be required to file a DSM Plan. However, OUC has already filed a DSM Plan, consisting of existing programs, which should be acknowledged by the Commission for informational purposes. OUC should not be required to file program standards.
