The Citizens of the State of Florida, through their attorney, the Public Counsel, hereby seek an extension of time to respond to Aloha's Motion to Terminate Informal Proceeding and Convene a Formal Proceeding. As grounds, the Citizens submit:

1. On July 12, 2004, Aloha Utilities, Inc. ("Aloha") filed a Motion to Terminate, and served OPC by U.S. Mail. Under Rule 28-106.204 F.A.C., the Office of Public Counsel's ("OPC's") response is due July 24. The OPC attorney assigned to this case has been out of town since July 16, and will again be out of town until July 26.

2. In order to evaluate Aloha's pleading and to provide a more considered response, the Citizens are seeking to extend the responsive due date to August 2, 2004.


