

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

On July 18, 2002, the Commission received a letter from Ms. Susan M. Hafeli dated July 17, 2002, which advised that A.R.C. Networks, Inc. d/b/a InfoHighway had purchased the customer base of North American Communications Control, Inc. (NACC). This was approved by the Commission in Docket No. 020757-TI.

On June 6, 2003, the Commission received a letter from Ms. Bridgette Nally, Controller, dated June 3, 2003, which appeared to be a request for cancellation of its IXC certificate. Ms. Nally advised that NACC "has had no business in the telecom industry as of September 31, 2002." The letter went on to state that NACC was in the process of being dissolved.

I wrote Ms. Nally on June 12, 2003, and advised that if NACC was requesting cancellation of its certificate, the company needed to pay the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee. No response was received; therefore, I called Ms. Nally at 631-588-3162 and left a voice mail message. No response has been received to date.

As information, Commission rules require that if a certificate is active for any day during a calendar year, the Regulatory Assessment Fee is owed for that year. I have since searched the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations' records and found where the company filed an "Application by foreign corporation for withdrawal of authority to transact business or conduct affairs in Florida" on November 4, 2002. Unfortunately, the Florida Public Service Commission was never notified that NACC wished to cancel its certificate in Florida. Because of this, NACC's IXC certificate remains active. This means the company owes the 2003 and 2004 Regulatory Assessment Fees, plus statutory late payment charges.

I also searched the New York Department of State, Division of Corporations' records and found your name and address for NACC. According to that website, NACC is an active corporation in New York.

NACC is continuing to accrue Regulatory Assessment Fees, plus statutory late payment charges. Therefore, if the company is no longer in business and has need of its IXC certificate in Florida, can you please write us a letter and specifically request cancellation of the certificate and pay the 2003 and 2004 Regulatory Assessment Fees?



Dear Ms. Nully:

The Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF) is due by January 30th of each year for the preceding calendar year. For certificate holders, the RAF is owed even if a telecommunications company may not have started operations or had any revenues. Since payment has not been made, statutory penalty and interest charges are now applicable.

Our records show that the 2003 RAF return notice was mailed on December 12, 2003, and a delinquent notice was mailed on February 20, 2004. As of this date, our records do not show receipt of the RAF return or payment. A copy of the 2003 RAF return form is enclosed. If full payment, including penalty and interest charges, along with the RAF return form, are not received by July 2, 2004, a docket may be established. Since this will be the third time a docket is established for the same rule violation, staff intends to recommend cancellation of the company's certificate if you do not respond. Please note that once a docket has been established, just paying the delinquent RAF amount will not prevent your certificate from being cancelled.

If you wish to cancel your certificate voluntarily and leave in good standing with the Commission, your company should pay the past due amount in full, complete the 2003 RAF return form, either pay the 2004 RAF or provide a date certain it will be paid, and comply with the requirements of Rule 25-24.474, Florida Administrative Code, copy enclosed. Any unpaid RAFs, including penalty and interest charges, are turned over to collections. When returning payment and a copy of the completed 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form, please use the enclosed blue envelope, which will insure prompt processing.

25-24.474 Cancellation of a Certificate.

(1) The Commission may on its own motion cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

(a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;


- (b) Violation of Commission rule or order; or
- (c) Violation of Florida Statutes.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:

- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
- (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (c) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.
- (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.

(3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).

Dear Certificate Holder:

The Division of the Commission's Clerk and Administrative Services has forwarded your account to our office to address the nonpayment of the Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) required by Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, for the year 2003, which was due January 30, 2004. The RAFs return form was mailed to you on **December 15, 2003**, and to date, Commission records reflect that payment has not been received.

According to Florida Law, you are required to add interest charges at 12% per annum, and a 5% penalty for each 30-day period or fraction thereof, beyond the due date, up to a maximum of 25% in addition to the delinquent amount due. In addition, pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes, the Commission is authorized to impose upon any entity subject to its jurisdiction a penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each offense, if such entity is found to have refused to comply with or to have willfully violated any lawful rule or order of the Commission, or any provision of Chapter 364.

Utilities are charged with knowledge of our rules and statutes. Moreover, it is general Commission practice that all utilities that apply for Interexchange Telephone certificate receive a copy of all applicable rules. Further, in accordance with Section 364.335, Florida Statutes, as part of the application process, utilities provide an affidavit indicating that they have read and understood the applicable rules.

If you wish to request another form, please contact David Brown or Valorie Moore at the number below. The payment should be identified with the company code and the company's name. Failure to provide payment within 15 days of this notice will result in the establishment of a docket to address your failure to return the RAFs form and pay RAFs in accordance with Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code. As specified above, pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes, the Commission may impose a fine or cancel your certificate. Therefore, it is important that you address this matter now.

If you have paid your fees, please provide us with your check number and the date that it was paid.
